The **Family Law Information Center (FLIC)** helps pro se parties complete any necessary forms needed in their respective family law cases on Friday mornings at the Family Law Information Center at the RJC.

Each week four pro se individuals are scheduled for a 1/2 hour of consultation with a volunteer attorney. The average time commitment per volunteer attorney is one hour, one Friday morning, approximately every other month.
